Recommended: Stay away from passkeys. Double certification is safer (getting a code to check-in). It is best to use a password with 4 figures added to it. If you don't log in every six months, you may need to change password. ID.me is an online identification service that lets you prove who you are once, then use that same login to access many government and private websites.

Password Tracker is recommended. Passwords need to be backed up. Be careful of messages on web browser-- If you see a message "you need to change your password," shut down-- do not save.
